CREA UN TEXTO INSTRUCTIVO O REDACTA UNA HISTORIA ORDENADA CRONOLÓGICAMENTE USANDO CONECTORES DE SECUENCIA. FIRST, THEN, NEXT, AFTER THAT, FINALLY

Instrucciones: busca un texto instructivo, el cual puede ser una receta, un manual de instrucciones de algún aparato, etc.

Escribe los pasos a seguir, ejemplo: step 1: buy the ingredients, step 2: cut the meat, step 3: boil the noodles, etc. al tener los pasos ordenados, agrega al comienzo de cada paso los conectores de secuencia, los cuales son:

First: primero

Next: siguiente

Then: luego

After that: después de eso

Finally: finalmente

Recuerda que first siempre debe ir en el primer paso y finally en el ultimo

Ejemplo:

First, buy the ingredients

Next, cut the meat

Then boil the noodles

After that, mix all the ingredients

Finally, serve and enjoy

Then, Make a vertical line from the eyeliner to the eyelid line



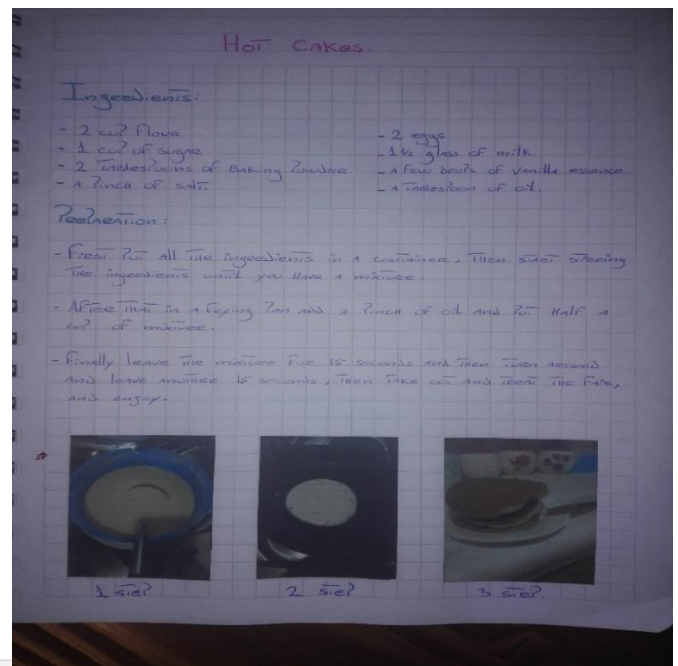
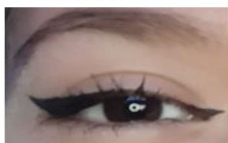
After, join both lines and draw one on the lash line
