Compound adjectives

Some adjectives can consist of two or more words. These are **compound adjectives**. Compound adjectives are usually written with **hyphens** when they are used in front of a noun they modify. For example, in the phrase 'man-eating lion', 'man-eating' is a compound adjective. 'man eating lion' means something different. As you can see, a hyphen changes the meaning of a phrase.

*She has a well-behaved child.
He is a good-looking young man.*
