1.We use the verb MAKE when someone <u>creates</u>, <u>constructs</u> <u>or builds something</u>:

make <u>a dress</u> make <u>a cake</u>



2.We often use MAKE when we refer to preparing food of any kind:

make a meal

make a cup of coffee

make breakfast

3.When we MAKE something - this activity usually creates something that you can touch:

make a cake

1.We use the verb DO when someone performs an action, activity or task:

do a crossword

do the washing up

2.We often use DO when we refer to work of any kind:

do your work

do homework

do housework

do your job

3. When we DO something - this activity doesn't usually produce a physical object:

do your job
