There is / are + A/AN, SOME, ANY

<div style="border: 1px solid black; border-radius: 50%; padding: 10px; display: inline-block; background-color: #42a5f5; color: white;">Some</div>	→	USE: With Countables and Uncountables in AFFIRMATIVE sentences. <u>Example:</u> There is SOME sugar. There are SOME apples.
<div style="border: 1px solid black; border-radius: 50%; padding: 10px; display: inline-block; background-color: #8bc34a; color: white;">Any</div>	→	USE: With Countables and Uncountables in NEGATIVE AND INTERROGATIVE sentences. <u>Example:</u> There isn't ANY sugar. There aren't ANY apples. Is there ANY sugar ? Are there ANY apples ?
