ADVERBS OF MANNER

An 'adverb of manner' used to express manner & state and explain how an action is carried out.

It helps to make sentences more interesting by adding more detail to the situation.

They are derived from adjectives and end in -ly. **(The test question is How / In what manner?)**

Adverbs of Manner are: bravely, easily, foolishly, clearly, hard, carefully, well, fast, like, with, quickly, badly, slowly, sadly, safely, softly, loudly, warmly, sweetly, diligently, rapidly, suddenly, secretly, openly, frankly, quietly, completely, correctly, so, thus etc.

Examples : (1) The soldiers fought bravely. (Question : How did they fight?)
 (2) He talks like his father. (Question : In what manner does he talk?)

Adverbs are usually formed by adding -ly to an adjective

nice	nicely
bad	badly
loud	loudly

-le gentle	-ly gently
-y easy	-ily easily
-ic enthusiastic	-ically enthusiastically
-ue true	-uly truly
-ll full	-ully fully

hard – **hard** good – **well** fast – **fast** early – **early** little – **little** much – **much**
