What are Question tags?

Question tags are short questions that come at the end of statements. They are commonly used in spoken

English to:

- (1.) start a conversation
- (2.) request information in a more polite way
- (3) soften an order or request for someone to do something



How are Question Tags formed?

+	-
Positive statement,	negative tag?
Snow is white,	isn't it?
-	+
Negative statement,	positive tag?
You don't like me,	do you?

1) We form question tags with an auxiliary verb + a pronoun.

- ✓ The bus will come soon, won't it?
- ✓ Judy wasn't there, was she?

positive statement (+)	negative tag (-)	negative statement (-)	positive question tag(+)
Snow <u>is</u> white,	<u>isn't it?</u>	You <u>don't</u> like it,	<u>do you?</u>

2) If the main statement has an auxiliary verb or modal verb, we use the same auxiliary verb in the tag question:

- a) You could make a better ad than that, couldn't you ?
- b) You ought to have finished by now, oughtn't she?
- c) You aunt is writing an advertisement, isn't she?
- d) He didn't go to the cinema, did he?
- e) There hasn't been any rain, has there?

3) If there is no auxiliary in the main statement, we add "do, does, or did", depending on the tense:

- ☞ She needs some help, doesn't she?
- ☞ You dislike loud music, don't you?

⇒ He loved his work, didn't he?

4) If the verb is "am" in the positive statement, we use "aren't" in the question tag:

a) I'm late, aren't I?

b) Oh, I am wrong, aren't I?
